Internationally recognized as one of the founding fathers of hand surgery, Dr. Osterman is a professor of Hand and Orthopaedic Surgery at Thomas Jefferson University. He is the current president of the Philadelphia Hand to Shoulder Center and the current director of their Hand Fellowship program.



Dr. Osterman divides his time as a clinician, a professor, and an author. Dr. Osterman edited one of the most popular hand surgery texts, *Rehabilitation of the Hand*, and he also wrote *Fractures and Injuries of the Distal Radius and Carpus: The Cutting Edge*. He has authored or coauthored over 300 articles and publications and continues his research endeavors with active grants from multiple sources.

When not treating patients, Dr. Osterman not only teaches locally but also around the world, having been a visiting professor at over 50 institutions and taught in over 180 countries. His leadership roles include past president of the American Association for Hand Surgery (AAHS) and current chairman of the Hand Fellowship Directors for the American Society for Surgery of the Hand (ASSH).
